7. OLD BUSINESS

7.1 Tri-City Commission Meeting – Vice-Chair, Commissioner Churchill

BACKGROUND: On January 16, 2015, the Fremont, Newark and Union City Senior Commissioners held a joint meeting for the first time. This meeting was such a success, that the three commissions decided they wanted to have joint meetings on a regular basis. The second of these meetings was in Fremont on Friday, March 16, 2018. Union City hosted the third Tri-City Meeting on Tuesday, October 16, 2018.

8. NEW BUSINESS

8.1 FY 2019-2022 Social Services Grant Process Update

BACKGROUND: Four agencies have applied for Social Service Grant funding under the Senior Services category. The total amount requested

from the four applications is \$147,000 per fiscal year. The Senior Citizens Commission (SSC) has approximately \$95,000 for FY 2019-2020 funding recommendations.

Human Relations Commission Chairperson Moore is proposing to request an increase in grant funding, commensurate with increases in the General Fund, over the last 3 years. Staff is recommending that the SCC make a referral to increase funding to the City Manager and or the City Council. Chairperson Moore is here to present the item to the Senior Commission for their concurrence.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the request and make a recommendation to the City Manager and or the City Council for an increase in Social Service Grant funding.

BACKGROUND: The City of Fremont is building a second senior center in Warm Springs Area.
