



Legal Clinics at the Fremont Family Resource Center

Bay Area Legal Aid provides free help with civil legal problems regarding housing, public benefits, health care access, and domestic violence prevention. Help includes legal advice, referrals, and possible representation in the following areas for low-income people:

Housing Preservation: public, subsidized, and private housing; fair housing and housing discrimination; housing conditions; lock-outs; utility shut-offs; residential hotels

Public Benefits: CalWORKs; SSDI; SSI; Food Stamps; General Assistance; Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants

Health Care Access: Medi-Cal; Denti-Cal; Medicare; Healthy Families; In-Home Support Services; ParaTransit Services; mental health services; HMO issues

Domestic Violence: temporary restraining orders; legal separation or annulment; divorce; child or spousal support; custody and visitation orders; immigration issues; Violence Against Women Act enforcement **for domestic violence survivors only**

Youth Justice: Foster Care benefits; Kin-Gap; Adoption Assistance Program (AAP); SSI for minors; CalWORKs – Kids Only; Special Education

Consumer Law Issues: Debt collection lawsuits; errors on credit reports; identity theft; harassment by debt collectors; bankruptcy; foreclosure rescue scams
