


Irvington will be home to Fremont's third BART Station. The Station Site Plan will address all the station components and focus on the station itself. The Station Area Plan will create a framework for future development near the station and will address transportation and circulation, urban design, and public infrastructure. The City recently updated its General Plan and zoning to support development of more multi-family residential around the station. No further land use or zoning changes are anticipated.

IRVINGTON BART STATION AREA PLAN MAP




SELF-GUIDED WALKING TOUR



PLANNING FOR THE IRVINGTON BART STATION HAS BEGUN... The City of Fremont and BART are working together to create two plans for the future station: the Station Site Plan and the Station Area Plan.

This self-guided walking tour was created to provide more context for community members about the Irvington BART Station Site. The public is invited to visit the site and experience the future location of the BART Station. This 1/2 mile walking tour takes 30-60 minutes to complete. Please take care when walking by staying on the sidewalks, using crosswalks, and obeying signals.

The elevated platforms would be located directly above the tracks. A concourse and pedestrian walkway would be provided for access to and from the station entry points and parking lots.
