Please see the following email from City Manager Mark Danaj:

City of Fremont Employees,

As I shared with you yesterday, Police Chief Petersen and the Police management team are monitoring potential protests being planned in and around Fremont today and we expect City Hall may be impacted. We do not currently have reason to believe the actions will be dangerous to City staff but, in an abundance of caution, **any staff not specifically designated to support public safety's response to the protests should leave the City Hall and Development Center campuses by 12:00 pm.** Employees that cannot telework from an alternate location will receive paid administrative leave.

I still anticipate that we will be able to resume a more conventional reporting schedule on Thursday, June 4 but I will update you if the situation changes. Please help us keep our Fremont team safe today. If you have questions or concerns, please contact your department management teams.
