3.1 FY 2016-18 CDBG Funding Process – Interviews for Applicants

The FY 2016-2018 funding process for the Community Development Block Grant Program is underway. The deadline to submit proposals was January 28th, 2016. Staff had received 4 capital proposals and 2 microenterprise proposals through ZoomGrants, the on-line application that the City uses for the funding process.

Committee Members and staff independently reviewed the proposals and prepared questions for the agencies. The responses from agencies were received by February 19th, 2016.

Committee Members and staff will be interviewing the agencies according to a pre-determined schedule. Each agency will be given 8 minutes with the interview panel. Agencies will have an opportunity to present their proposed program during the first four minutes of the interview, followed by another four minutes of questions and answers to further clarify their proposal. Each agency may bring a maximum of three representatives from your agency. Following is the interview schedule:
