



# BART WAY AND GATEWAY PLAZA BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

## Project Highlights:

- ➔ Replacement of existing sidewalk with wider colored concrete sidewalks
- ➔ Installation of decorative street and pedestrian lights
- ➔ Removal and replacement of trees on BART Way and Civic Center Drive
- ➔ Curb ramp upgrades at intersections, and a new traffic signal at Civic Center Drive and BART Way
- ➔ New pedestrian wayfinding directional signs to and from BART Way to Downtown Fremont
- ➔ Elevated to curb level green bike lanes on BART Way



## Pardon Our Progress

Construction is scheduled to begin July 19, 2018 with an anticipated completion date of December 2018. Impacts due to construction will include:

- Lane closures on BART Way
- Portions of blocked sidewalk from BART Way to Gateway Plaza
- Reduced parking at Gateway Plaza due to additional sidewalk construction
- On-street parking at BART Way will no longer be available

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The BART Way and Gateway Plaza Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvements Project provides pedestrian and bike-friendly connections from the Fremont BART Station to Civic Center Drive through Gateway Plaza to Capitol Avenue in Downtown Fremont. It is Phase 3 of Downtown Fremont infrastructure improvements followed by the extension of Capitol Avenue from Fremont Boulevard to State Street and improvements from Capitol Avenue to Paseo Padre Parkway.
