Republic Services will pick up compostable trees from your complex at no charge.



CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION OPTIONS

Special container	Special pickup	Extra collections
Republic will drop off a roll-off container free of charge, as long as it is used for compostable holiday trees only. We recommend you reserve yours as soon as possible.	Complexes with no space for a roll-off box or too small to warrant one can designate a drop-off area and schedule a collection day directly with Republic.	Arrange for your containers to be serviced more often than usual in January.

Alternatively, residents may take their tree to Republic Services Center or pay the Boy Scouts to pick it up, as noted on the flyer (reverse side).

A few things to keep in mind:

- Non-compostable trees are not eligible for free collection. They should be placed in trash containers, delivered to Republic Services Center, or picked up for an additional fee.
- Keep areas in and around enclosures free of trees and extra trash so Republic can service your regular bins and carts.
- Drivers cannot service containers if items are piled higher than the edge of the box.
- The enclosed Christmas tree disposal flyer can be reprinted and posted or distributed to your residents.
- Inform residents about where and how to discard trees.

The cooperation from you and your residents will help ensure a safe holiday for all.

CHRISTMAS TREE DISPOSAL

Options for Multi-Family Dwellings

DEAR RESIDENTS: Please help avoid clutter and fire hazards by properly disposing of your Christmas tree.

COMPOSTABLE TREES



- Benefit the environment and free up trash container space.
- Avoid buying trees with flocking or fire retardant.
- Remove decorations, tinsel, nails and tree stands before discarding.
- Compostable trees should be placed at the location designated by the Property Manager.

NON-COMPOSTABLE TREES



- Trees with flocking, fire retardant, decorations, tinsel, nails, tree stands.
- Cut up and place in the garbage container.
- Do not place trees next to containers or inside trash enclosures.
- Do not overfill containers (items piled higher than the edge of the box).
