WHAT IS THE CENTERVILLE COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT?

The Centerville Complete Streets project will improve segments of Fremont Boulevard (Alder Ave. to Eggers Dr.), Thornton Avenue (west of Fremont Blvd.), and Peralta Boulevard (Fremont Blvd. to Sequoia Rd.). The project site is located in the heart of the Centerville commercial district and within close proximity to numerous schools, businesses, AC Transit bus lines, and the Centerville ACE/Amtrak train station.

The recent relinquishment of State Route 84 allows the City to have local control over this street right-of-way to repave the streets and implement "complete streets" improvements to enhance safety and mobility for all users, including drivers, pedestrians, bicyclists, school children, and businesses.

As part of the project, the City is conducting an extensive community engagement process to hear from stakeholders, including residents, schools, businesses, transit providers, and pedestrian and bicycle groups, on the project's design.

WHAT ARE COMPLETE STREETS?

Complete streets are streets that are safe, comfortable, and convenient for all users - including people walking, bicycling, driving, and riding transit - regardless of age or ability. A complete streets approach seeks to balance the needs of different modes of travel to provide a transportation network that is beneficial to everyone.
