Provide public comment: Public comment will be accepted from those attending in person and individuals participating remotely by phone during the live meeting.

- There may be limited seating.
- Meetings are held at the District Office, 4210 Technology Drive, CA 94538.
- The district will default to its regular practice of community members completing the public speaking card, which will be available on meeting day.
