This is notice of the City of Fremont's intent to award a contracts to **DKS Associates, Fehr & Peers, Hexagon Transportation Consultants and W-Trans** as the selected vendors for the above-referenced project.

A bidder who wishes to protest the proposed award must submit the bid protest in writing to the Purchasing Department before 5:00 p.m. on the fifth business day following the posting date of this Notice of Intent to Award. All protests shall be in writing and shall contain a complete statement of the legal grounds for the protest; all the facts relevant to the protest; and the form of relief requested and the legal basis for such relief. All protests shall be accompanied by all documentation supporting the grounds for the protest. The protest shall include the name, address and telephone number of the protesting party and the person representing the protesting party, if any.

Per Article VIII, Item 3.20.330 of the Purchasing Code: Protests may be submitted only by a party that has submitted a bid or proposal in response to the contract solicitation. A subcontractor of a bidder or proposer may not submit a protest. A party may not rely on a protest submitted by another party, they must timely pursue their own protest.

**A protest that merely requests a re-evaluation of a proposal's content will not be entertained.**

Protests can only be submitted by the party that submitted the bid or proposal by the following method:
