**On behalf of the City of Fremont, I extend my deep gratitude to you for considering and selecting the City's requests for Fiscal Year (FY) 2027 Community Project Funding (CPF).** I appreciate the assistance provided by Carly Sincavitch from your team in helping the City navigate the CPF application process.

I am delighted to see that the following City projects were selected by you and your office for CPF:

- **Improvement of Lake Elizabeth** (*requested amount of \$3 million*): This project will support implementation of the City's Lake Management Plan to improve water quality and restore the ecological health of Lake Elizabeth in Central Park.
