Dear Congressman Khanna:

**On behalf of the City of Fremont, thank you for your consideration and selection of the City's requests for Fiscal Year (FY) 2027 Community Project Funding (CPF).** I would also like to extend my gratitude to your staff for their work throughout the CPF application process. The following projects, which you have selected for FY 2027 CPF, will support the nation's broader effort to promote and enhance transportation safety and infrastructure:

- **Hetch-Hetchy Trail Gap Closure Across Scott Creek Road** (*requested amount of \$3 million*): This project seeks to extend the Hetch-Hetchy Trail to connect neighborhood parks in Fremont and Milpitas with a safe street crossing near and at the intersection of Scott Creek Road and Zinfandel Street. This project will improve safety for park users and motorists who cross the heavily traveled Scott Creek Road. This project is being coordinated in partnership with the City of Milpitas, California.
- **Quiet Zone Corridor Project Across Walnut Avenue to Dixon Landing Road** (*requested amount of \$4 million*): This project seeks to improve safety at four railroad crossings in Fremont (three locations) and Milpitas (one location) to enable the creation of a railroad quiet zone and eliminate nighttime noise disturbances for neighborhoods along the railroad corridor due to loud train horn blasts. This project is being coordinated in partnership with the City of Milpitas, California.

Your advocacy, including your efforts to secure CPF for the City of Fremont's Auto Mall Parkway Center Median in previous years, has been vital in helping the City fund critical projects responsive to our community's needs and concerns. As the House Appropriations Committee reviews CPF requests from all members of Congress, I look forward to working with you to continue showcasing and advancing the City's projects that align with the nation's and Fremont residents' best interests.
